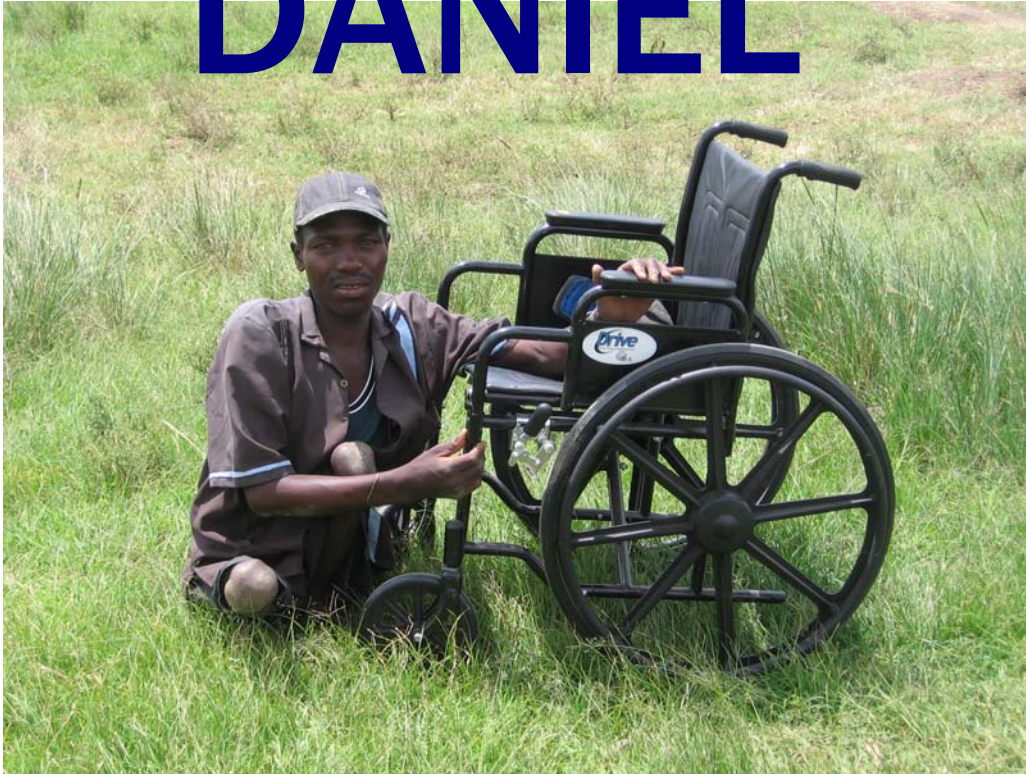




- By supporting Free The Children's Mobile Health Clinic, you are decreasing the incidence of disease in the community and changing the lives of thousands of community members.

Daniel Langat is 26 years old and has lived with a disability since he was a child. He attended Enlerai Primary School, one of the schools that Free The Children partners with. He stayed in school until Standard 6, then due to pressures at home and issues with his health, he had to drop out. He has been walking on his knees and hands for over a decade. When he found out that a wheelchair had been donated and he would be the recipient, he said *“I don’t know whether I am going to laugh or cry”*.
